

Volume X. Perinatal White Boards

Summary

Whenever an electronic maternity record is accessed there is a need to present selected information to the user.

Providing this sort of information helps to stop the computer being seen as a black hole with no feedback to the user in return for the data being entered.

The precise information displayed or easily accessible will depend on what is most relevant at that time of access. Some information e.g. Name of the Maternent or the Infant will always need to be displayed. Some will change e.g. Gestation of Pregnancy, Age of Neonate in Days. Some will only need to be displayed on request e.g. information specific to giving an Anaesthetic. (Updated May 2009)
